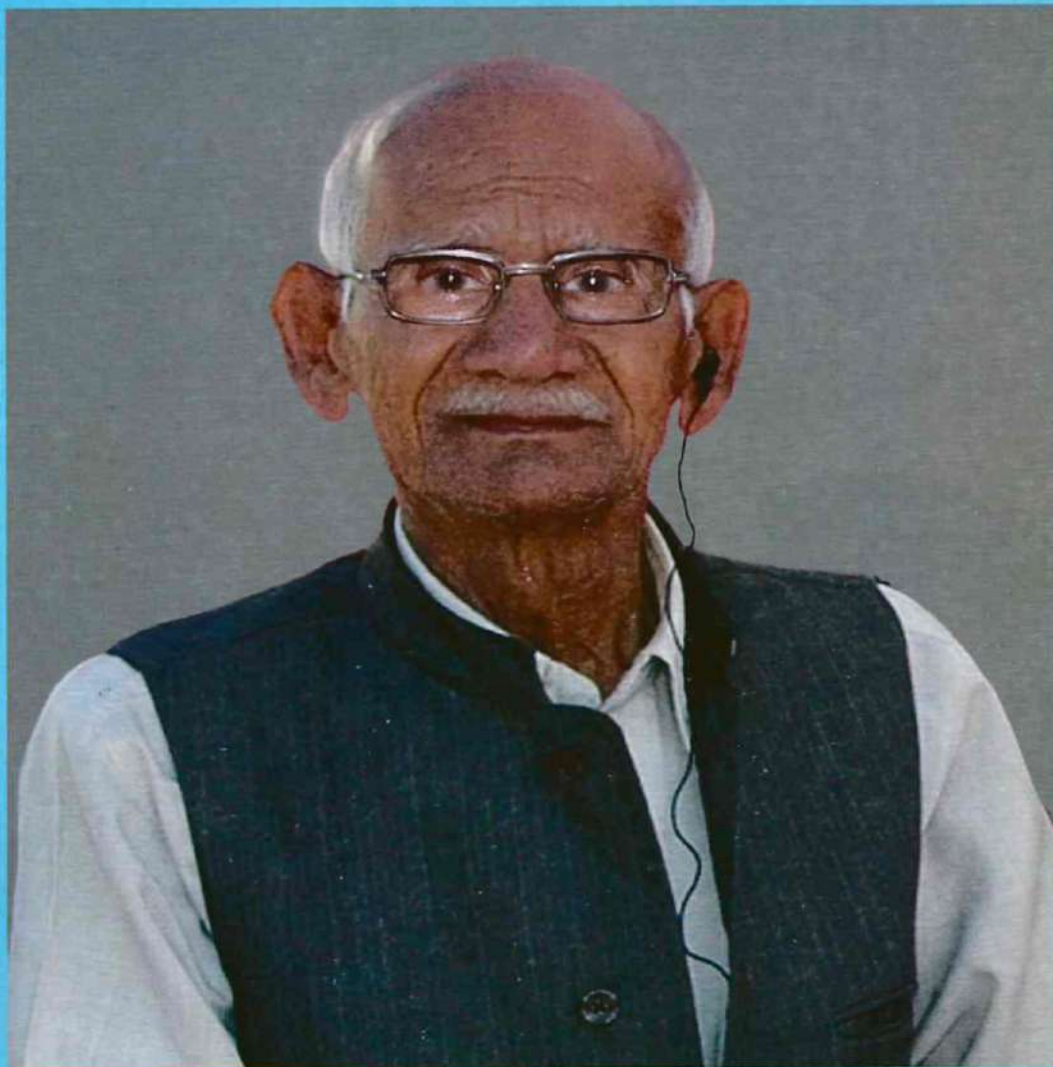

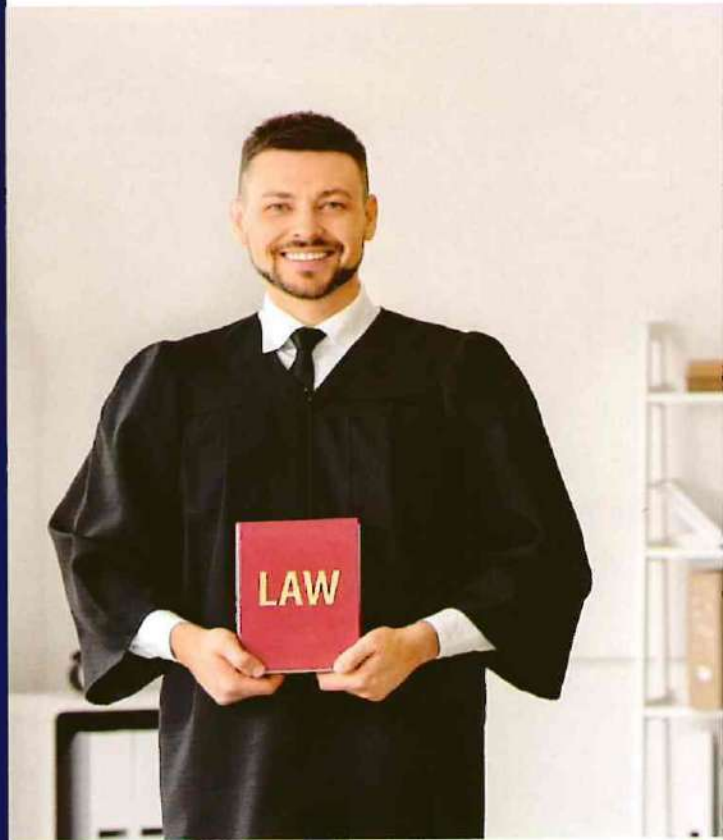

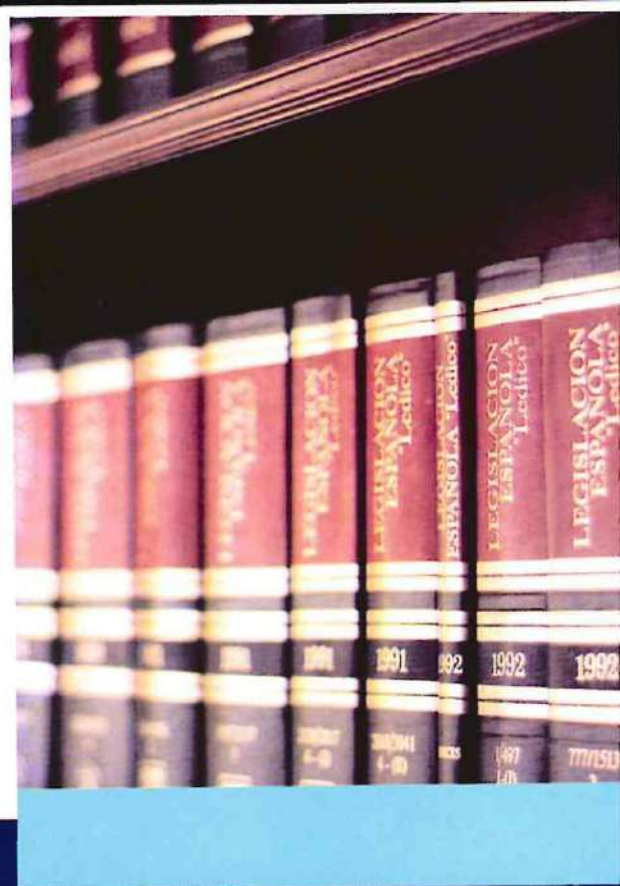

It covers core legal subjects, but BA LLB includes additional humanities subjects such as political science, sociology, and economics. Below is a breakdown of courses typically offered in each program:

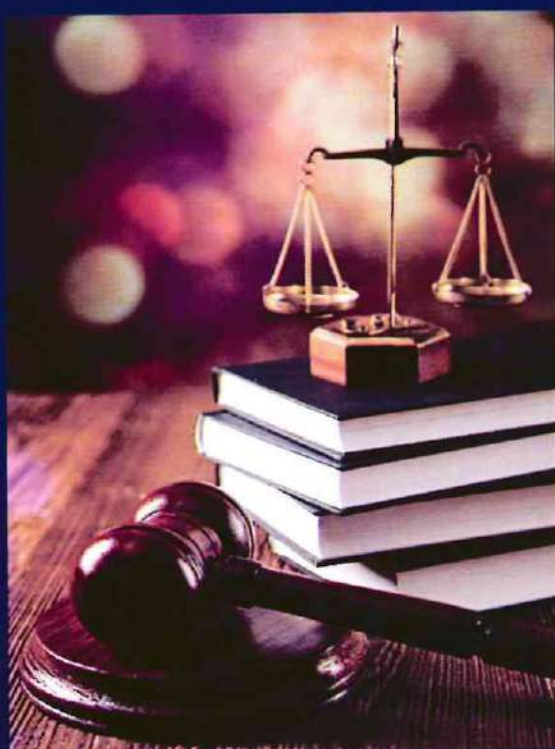


Course Duration

- For a 5-year integrated LLB: Completion of high school (10+2 or equivalent).

Reporting & Disciplinary Action

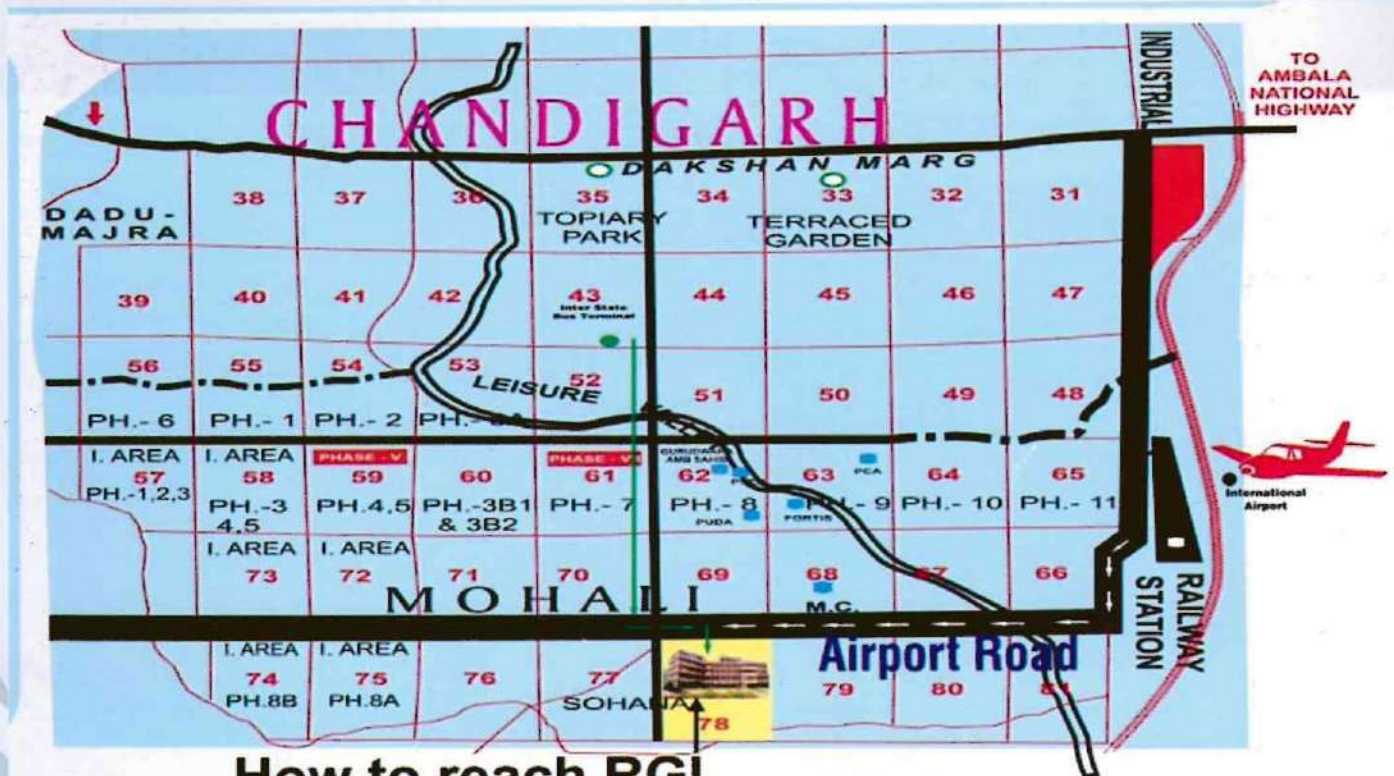
- Victims or witnesses can report ragging to faculty, wardens, or the Anti-Ragging Cell.
