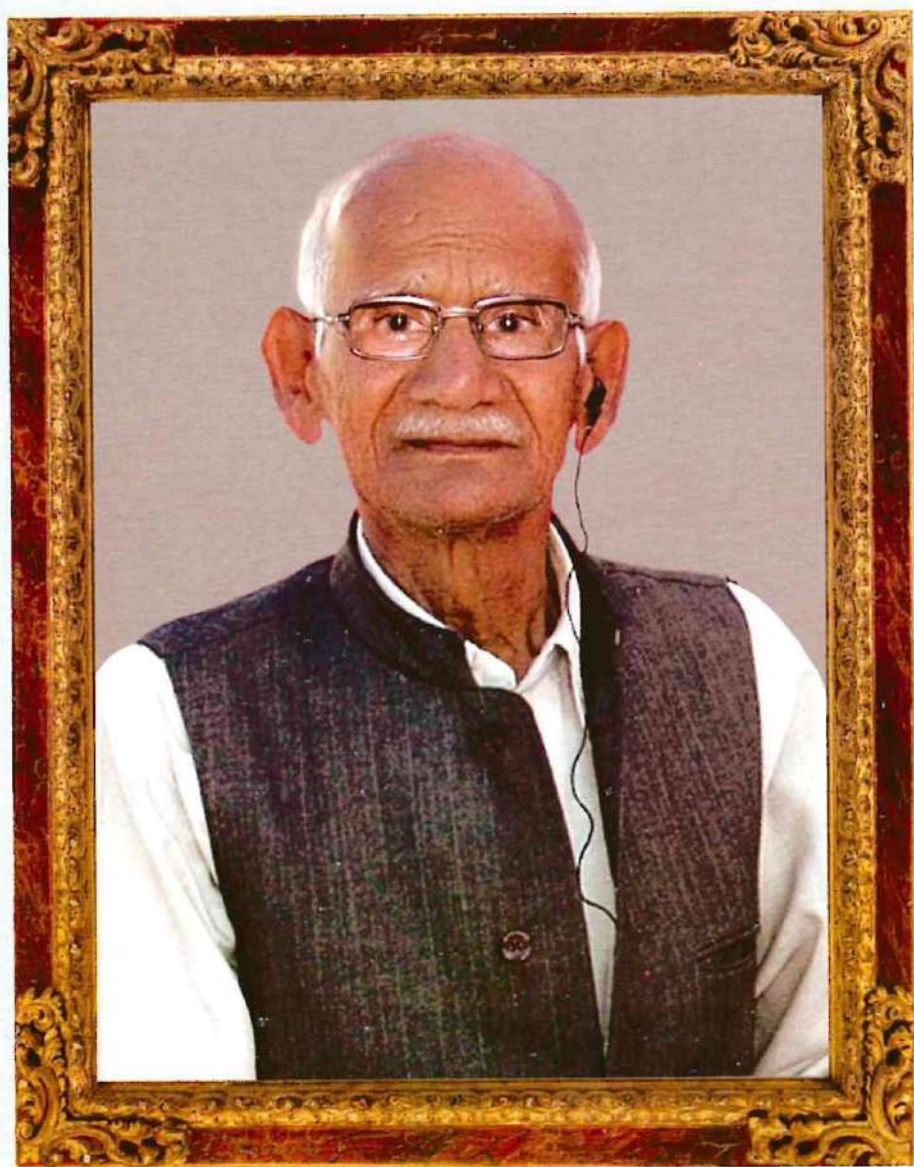

INTRODUCTION

Rattan Professional Education Society started a school in the name of B.S.H. Arya High School in 1952 in the village Sohana, Mohali, Punjab with the purpose of providing Education in the backward area. This School has now been upgraded as Senior Secondary School (+2).

The management of Rattan Professional Education Society (Regd.) established a Nursing institute in 1998 for providing best education and training to health professionals so as to facilitate the village communities to form Health & Welfare Committees for raising the health status and solving social economic and allied problems.

The first batch of 50 ANM/MPHW (F) joined 1 year 6 months Diploma Course in the year 1998. During the year 1999, permission for the 3-year General Nursing and Midwifery Course was granted by the Govt. of Punjab, Punjab Nurses Registration Council and Indian Nursing Council with intake of 60 students. The Institute started two year B.Sc. Nursing (Post Basic) course w.e.f. session 2006 and B.Sc. Nursing (Basic) Four Year Course started from 2009. M.Sc. Nursing Course was started in the year 2010 in three Nursing specialties namely Medical Surgical Nursing, Mental Health Nursing & Community Health Nursing and other two Nursing Specialties namely Paediatric Nursing and Obstetrical & Gynaecological Nursing were started in the year 2014.

College of Nursing is located on the outskirts of Mohali in Sec-78, on an 8.5 acre of land. The Infrastructure of the institute comprises of five-storey building equipped with modern facilities. Each floor has spacious classrooms, which are well ventilated. Laboratory section comprises of Microbiology laboratory, Anatomy & Physiology Laboratory, Nutrition laboratory, MCH Laboratory and a community health laboratory.

Computer laboratory is spacious with internet facility. E-Library is available. The institute library is enriched with literature, National and International Nursing journals and professional books & many research thesis.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Admission Fees & Tuition fees are payable in advance and are Non-refundable in full or part on any account whatsoever. If not paid in time, the name of the student will be struck off from the College records.
2. Discipline of the institute is to be strictly observed. For disobeying discipline the student observed. For disobeying the student may be fined or expelled from the institute. Decision of the Management Committee in this regard will be final.
3. Any harsh or insulting language used in the College Campus or written in the letter may affect the career of the student.
4. Student must check her eligibility while taking admission to particular course.
5. If a student fails to take examinations due to one or the other reason, college shall not entertain any claim for the refund of the fees.
6. In all matters, the decision of the Principal/ Director will be final.
7. Students are strictly forbidden to possess any of the following within the institute:-
 - a) The fire arms or any lethal weapons.
 - b) An addictive or hallucinogenic (mind bending) drugs.
 - c) The books/ journal of excite bases.
8. College will not be responsible for any delay or postponement of the final examination conducted by Baba Farid University Health Sciences & PNRC.
9. The Principal/Management Committee reserves the right to change the time-table at any time.
10. Leave application shall be submitted through the class teacher. Only reasonable leave will be considered. Application should be signed by the parents/guardians before proceeding on leave. Leave will not be sanctioned telephonically.
11. House examinations/tests are compulsory and these contribute to the internal assessment of the student.
12. Regular & Punctual attendance is compulsory in lectures, demonstrations, clinics, hospital, day & night duties.
13. Annual attendance in clinical experience is required as per syllabus.
14. Students, whose progress and conduct is not considered satisfactory, will not be allowed to appear for the examination.
15. Student will not take part in political activity of any kind during the course of her studies at the institute.
16. Students will not be allowed to entertain their parents/ guardians/ relatives or friends during the college hours and clinical area.
17. All the students shall comply with institution rules and regulations.
18. Students are not allowed to paste notices within the institution and are forbidden to address to any outside authority directly. Any student infringing this rule will be suspended.
19. Students may pay for damages caused by them to library books, lab articles or other institution property.
20. The Governing Body of the society reserves the right to add or delete any other regulation whenever required.
21. After successful completion of the course, the Institute does not guarantee any employment. However the certificate awarded to them will make them eligible for employment.
22. The student will have to pay all field-training charges if imposed by the Government of Punjab.

HOSTEL RULES

- *Hostel faculty is compulsory for all outstation students.*
- *No student shall keep any unauthorized person in the room. If a student is found to have a person in her room, she will be expelled from the hostel/college*

- *Food shall be provided in the mess hall and students are not allowed to carry food to their rooms.*
- *Photographs of their 4 relatives who can visit the student in the hostel should be submitted at the time of admission.*
- *The parents will write the names and give passport size photograph of relatives who would visit the students (not more than 5 member including parents). The warden holds the right to allow the visitors.*
- *Visitors are not allowed to visit the room.*
- *All lights and fan must be switched off while leaving the rooms to avoid a fine of Rs. 100/- per day.*
- *No hostel servant shall be sent on errands without the permission of the warden. Illness must be reported to the warden at once.*
- *The students are requested not to keep any valuables. In case of any damage or loss, the authorities will not be responsible.*
- *Visitors are allowed on Saturday after 2:00 p.m. & Sunday between 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.*
- *The Management Committee, whose decision will be final in every aspect, may be approached in case of any emergency.*
- *Warden holds the authority to grant day out pass to the students.*
- *No student is allowed to keep mobiles during college hours. In case of default, same will be confiscated and heavy fine will be imposed. On repeated fault, student will be rusticated without any claims.*

ANTI RAGGING POLICY

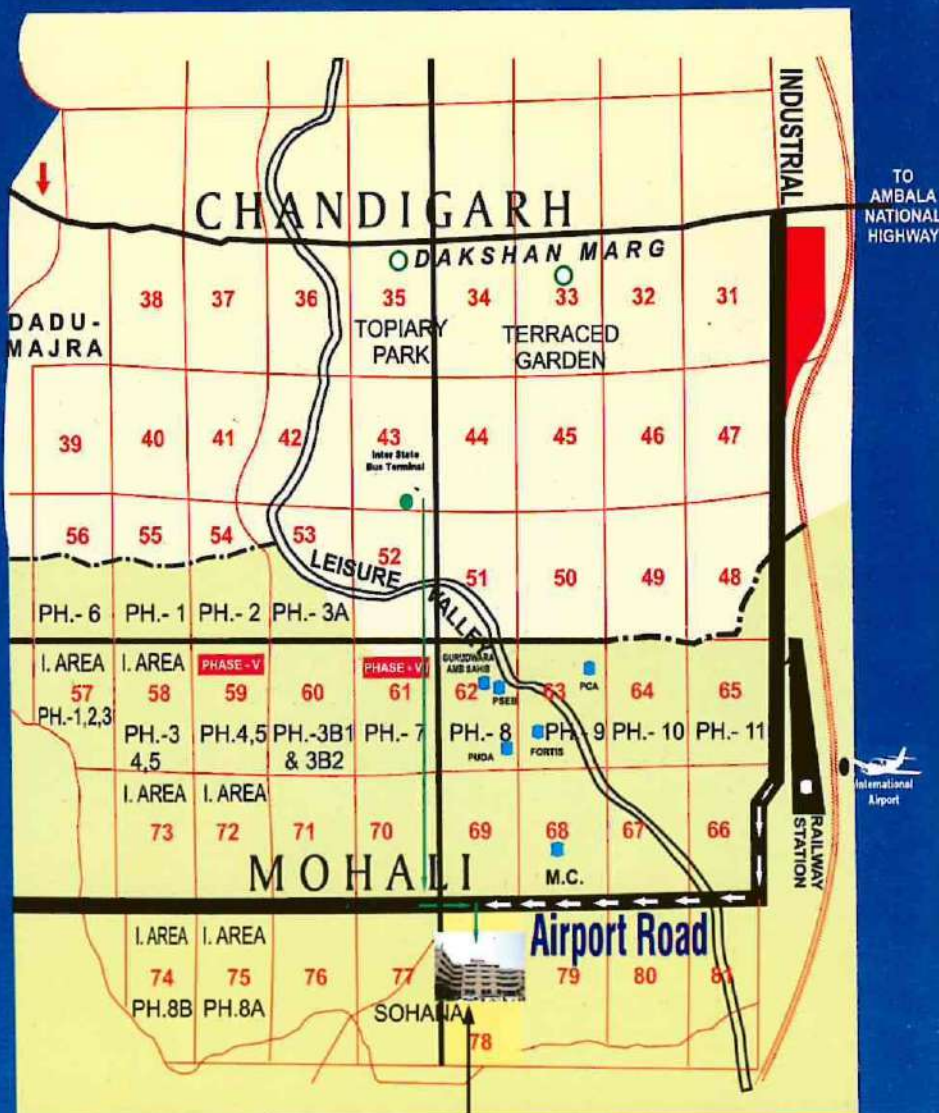
