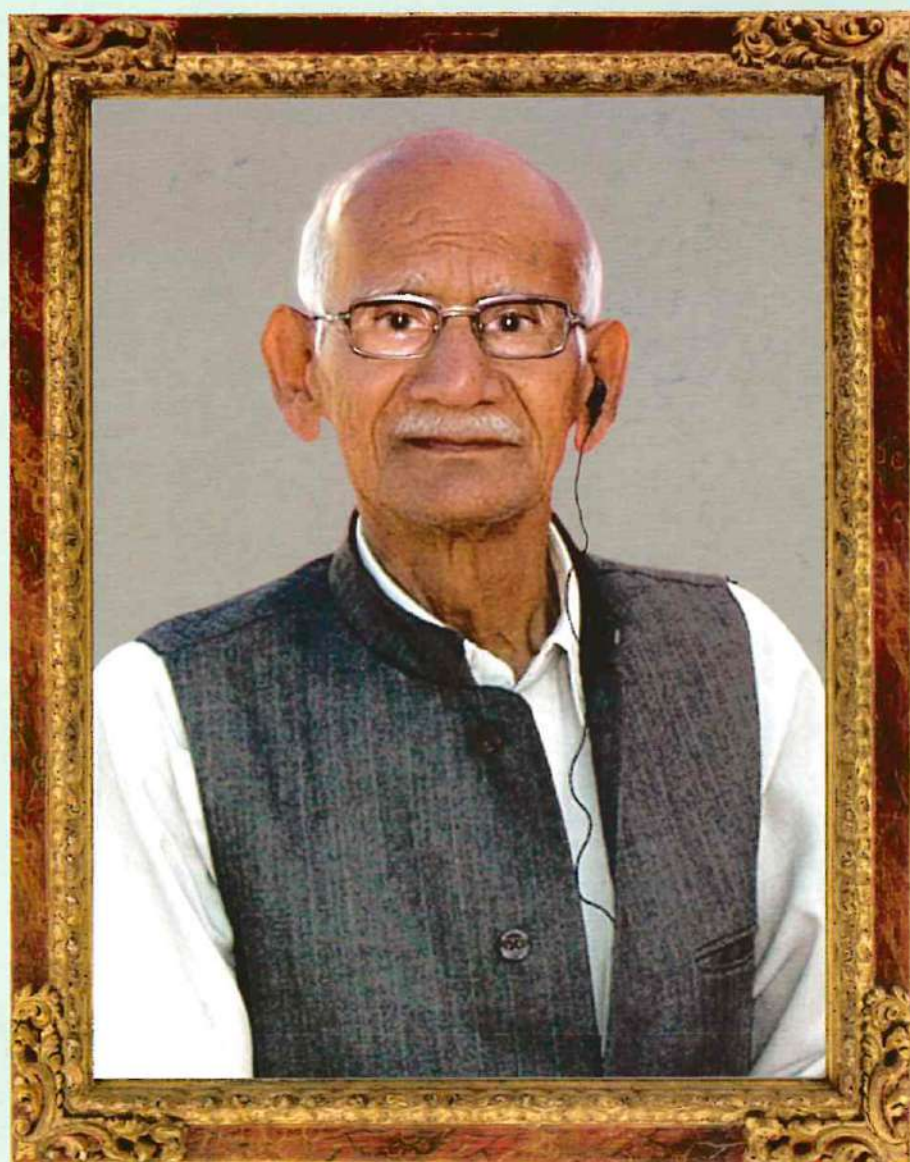

INTRODUCTION

Rattan Professional Education Society started a school in the name of B.S.H. Arya High School in 1952 in the village Sohana, Mohali, Punjab with the purpose of providing Education in Backward area. This School has now been upgraded as Senior Secondary School (+2).

The management of Rattan Professional Education Society (Regd) established a Nursing institute in 1998 for providing best education and training to the health professionals so as to facilitate the village community to form Health and Welfare committees for raising the health status and solving social economic and allied problems.

The first batch of 50 ANM/MPHW (F) joined 1 Year 6 Months diploma Course in the year 1998. During the year 1999, permission for 3-year General Nursing and Midwifery Course was granted by the Govt. of Punjab, Punjab Nursing Registration Council and Indian Nursing Council with intake of 60 students. The institute started 2 year B.Sc. Nursing (Post Basic) course w.e.f. session 2006 and B. Sc. Nursing (Basic) four-year course started from 2009. M.Sc. Nursing Course was started in the year 2010 in all five Nursing Specialties Namely Medical Surgical Nursing, Mental Health Nursing, Community Health Nursing, Child Health Nursing, Obstetric and Gynaecological Nursing

Rattan Group of institution is located at Mohali in Sec-78, on an 8.5 acre of land. The infrastructure of the institute comprises of five story building equipped with modern facilities. Each floor has spacious classroom, which are well ventilated. Laboratory section comprises of Microbiology laboratory, Biochemistry Laboratory, Anatomy & Physiology Laboratory, Anaesthesia & Operation Theatre Laboratory, Radiology and Imaging Technology Laboratory, Nursing Foundation Laboratory, Nutrition Laboratory, MCH Laboratory and community Health Laboratory.

Computer Laboratory is spacious with internet facility E- Library is available. The institute library is enriched with literature, nursing journals and professional books.

B.Sc. Medical Lab Sciences

The B.Sc. in Medical Lab Sciences is a Paramedical Programme that imparts both practical and theoretical knowledge on the use of clinical laboratory tests in the diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of various diseases and health issues. The best care and treatment for diseases are provided by medical laboratory specialists, who also play a critical role in disease diagnosis.

The programme teaches students how to recognize and identify ailments as well as the various treatments that can be used to treat them. Additionally, they learn about testing, documenting, and reporting pertinent data as well as gathering it through sampling and data collection.

Students who want to excel in the curriculum must have strong research skills and the ability to accurately complete assignments. Students should also have experience with computers and their software, a foundation in science, and a preference for employing scientific tools and equipment.

Duration: 3 Years (6 Semester)

Eligibility:

B.Sc. in Medical Lab Sciences-3 Years

Passing of 10+2 examination with Physics & Chemistry as compulsory subjects and either Mathematics or Biology from recognized Board / University / Council or 10+2 with vocational course in Medical Laboratory Science / Medical Laboratory Technology with atleast 50% marks (45% marks in case of candidate belonging to Reserved Category) in aggregate.

B.Sc. in Medical Lab Sciences (Lateral Entry)-2Years

Passing of Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology or Medical Laboratory Science or Pharmacy from recognized Punjab State Board of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Chandigarh or Two Year Diploma in Laboratory Assistant/ Medical laboratory Technology from J&K Para Medical & Nursing Council or such Examination from any other recognized State Board of Technical Education with atleast 50% marks (45% marks in case of candidate belonging to Reserved Category) in aggregate.

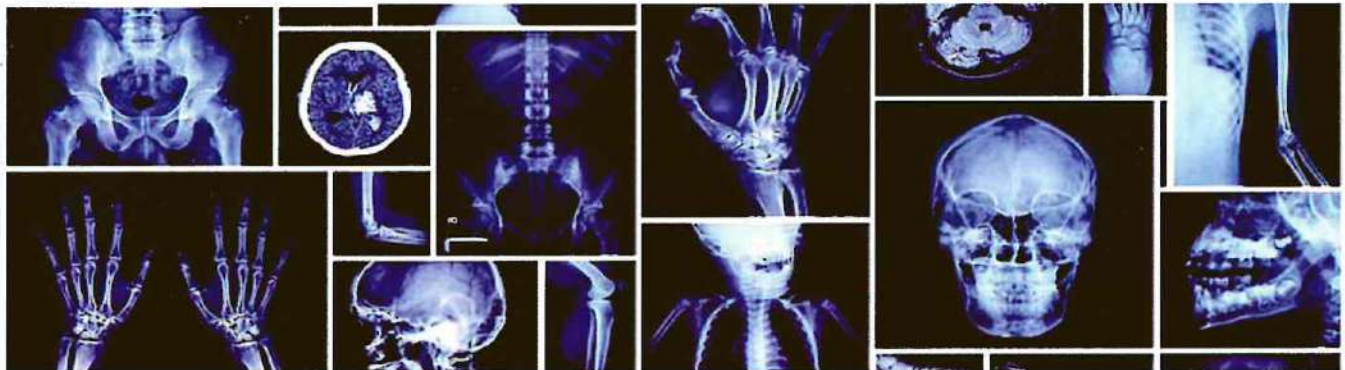

B.Sc. Radiology & Imaging Technology

Having passed Diploma in Medical Radiology and Imaging Technology with minimum aggregate of 50% marks.

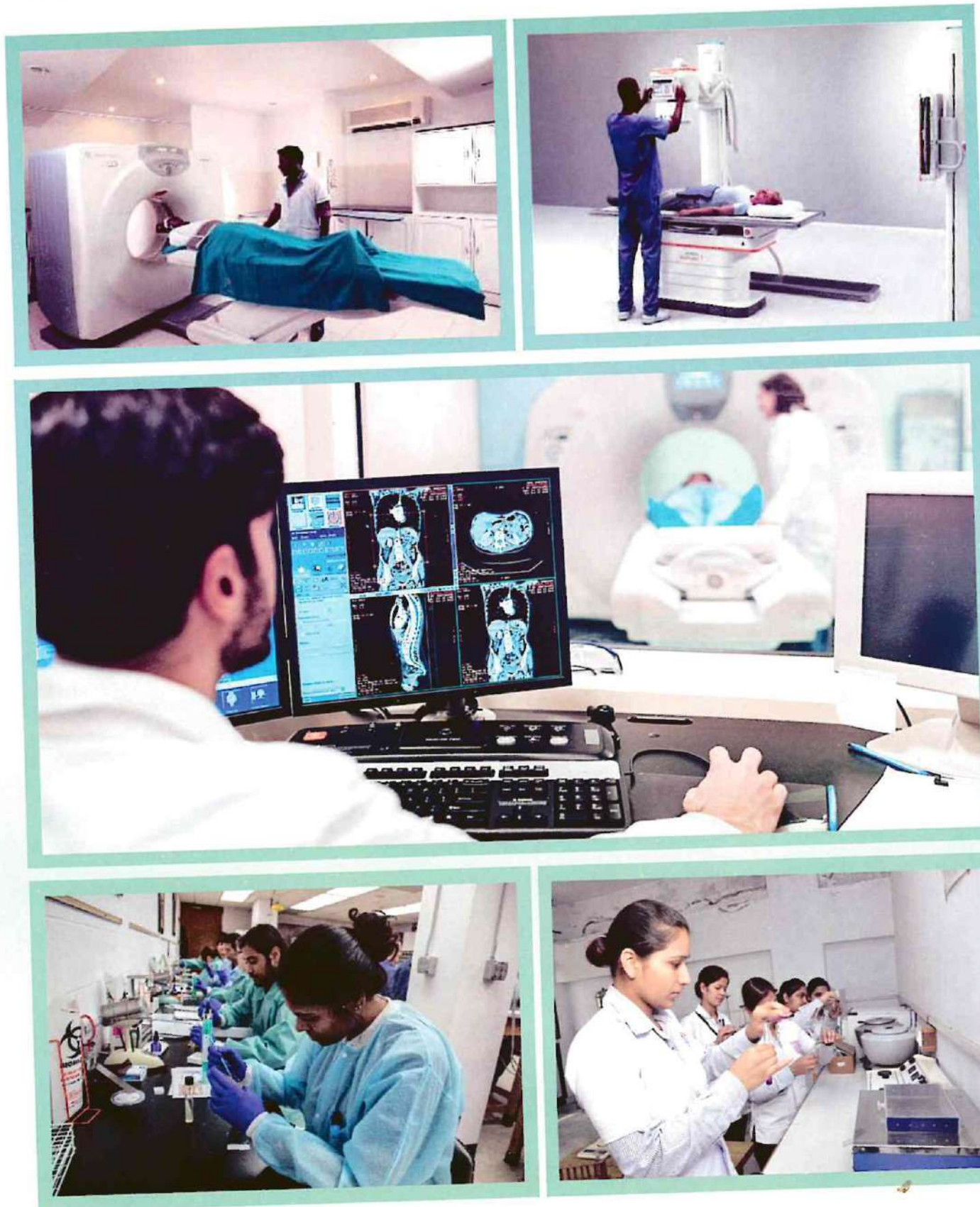

B.Sc. Medical Technology (Anesthesia and Operation Theatre)

An extensive knowledge of anesthetic techniques, supplies, and equipment is possessed by anesthesia technology specialists, who are allied healthcare professionals who help manage and monitor anesthesia. Their tasks include assisting Doctors in Surgery, arranging surgical instruments before surgery, sterilizing instrumentation before surgery, cleaning surgical instruments after surgery, carrying out Surgeons' commands during surgery and taking care of anesthesia equipment. The largest medical specialty in hospitals is anesthesiology & operation theatre technology, and all aspects of patient care make use of this specialty's expertise. In addition, anesthetists practice intensive care and pain treatment in addition to anesthesia. Numerous institutions and universities in India offer courses in anesthesia & operation theatre technology, giving students the chance to pursue careers as anesthesiologists.

Duration: 3 Years (6 Semester)

Eligibility: Passing of 10+2 examination with medical stream at least 50% aggregate and 55% Marks combined in Physics, Chemistry & Biology (45% in case reserved category) from any recognized board of school education.

OR

Diploma in Anaesthesia and Operation Theatre Technology with minimum aggregate of 50% marks.

Scope: Operation Theatres in hospitals, Emergency Care Departments as well as ICUs in hospitals are places where OT Technicians are needed. For any operation theatre to function smoothly, OT Technicians are needed!

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Admission Fees & Tuition fees are payable in advance and are **Non-refundable** in full or part on any account whatsoever. If not paid timely, the name of the student will be struck off from the College rolls.
2. The minimum fee for booking the seat will be Rs. 10,000/-
3. Discipline of the institute is to be strictly observed. Disobedience can lead to fine submission or expelling the student from the institute. Decision of the management committee in this regard will be final.
4. Any sort of verbal or physical abuse in the college campus may affect the career of the student.
5. Students must check their eligibility while taking admission to particular course.
6. If a student fails to attend the examinations due to one or the other reason, college shall not entertain any claim for the refund of the fees.
7. In all matters, the decision of the Principal/Director will be final.
8. Students are strictly forbidden to possess any of the following within the institute:-
 - The fire arms or any lethal weapon.
 - Any sedative or hallucinogenic drugs,
 - The books/ magazines other than educational purposes.
9. College will not be responsible for any delay or postponement of the final examination conducted by IKGPTU Jalandhar.
10. The Principal/ Management Committee reserve the right to change the time table at any time.
11. Leave application shall be submitted through the class teacher. Only reasonable leave will be considered. The application should be signed by the Parents/ Guardians before proceeding on leave. Leave will not be sanctioned telephonically.
12. House examinations/ Tests are compulsory and these contribute to the internal assessment of the students.
13. Regular & Punctual attendance is compulsory in lectures, demonstrations, clinics, hospital, day & night duties.
14. Annual attendance in clinical experience is required as per syllabus.
15. Students, whose progress and conduct is not considered satisfactory, will not be allowed to appear for the examinations
16. Student will not take part in political activities of any kind during the course of her studies at the institute.

17. Students will not be allowed to entertain their Parents/ Guardians, relatives or friends during the college hours and clinical area.
18. All the students shall comply with institution's Rules and Regulations.
19. Students are not allowed to paste notices within the institution and are forbidden to address to any outside authority directly. Any student infringing this rule will be suspended.
20. Students may pay for damages caused by them to library books, lab articles or other institution property.
21. The Governing body of society reserves the right and deletes any other regulation when ever required.
22. After successful completion of the course, the institute does not guarantee any employment. However the certificate awarded to them will make them eligible for employment.
23. The student will have to pay all field- training charges, if imposed by the Government of Punjab.
24. Mohali courts reserves the right of jurisdiction in all matters.

HOSTEL RULES

- Hostel faculty is compulsory for all outstation students
- No student shall keep any unauthorized person in the room. If a student is found to have a person in her room, she will be expelled from the hostel/college
- Each student must keep the room neat and clean allotted to her. She will be held responsible for any damage to room and furniture.
- The main gate of the hostel will be closed at 8:00 pm in winter and 9:00 p.m. in summer.
- Failure to return in time will be dealt seriously and strictly.
- In sickness, students should report to class teachers in teaching hours & in hostel to warden.
- Electrical appliance is not allowed to be used in the hostel rooms. Students are prohibited to manipulate any electrical wiring and plug point.
- Students are required to pay their mess bills by the 7th of every month positively. If failed, they have to leave the hostel.

- Food shall be provided in the mess hall and students are not allowed to carry food to their rooms.
- Photographs of their 4 relatives who can visit the student in the hostel should be submitted at the time of admission.
- The parents will write the names and give passport size photograph of relatives who would visit the students (not more than 5 member including parents). The warden holds the right to allow the visitors.
- Visitors are not allowed to visit the room.
- All lights and fan must be switched off while leaving the rooms to avoid a fine of Rs. 100/- per day.
- No hostel servant shall be sent on errands without the permission of the warden. Illness must be reported to the warden at once.
- The students are requested not to keep any valuables. In case of any damage or loss, the authorities will not be responsible.
- Visitors are allowed on Saturday after 2:00 p.m. & Sunday between 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- The Management Committee, whose decision will be final in every aspect, may be approached in case of any emergency.
- Warden holds the authority to grant day out pass to the students.
- No student is allowed to keep mobiles during college hours. In case of default, same will be confiscated and heavy fine will be imposed. On repeated fault, student will be rusticated without any claims.

ANTI RAGGING POLICY

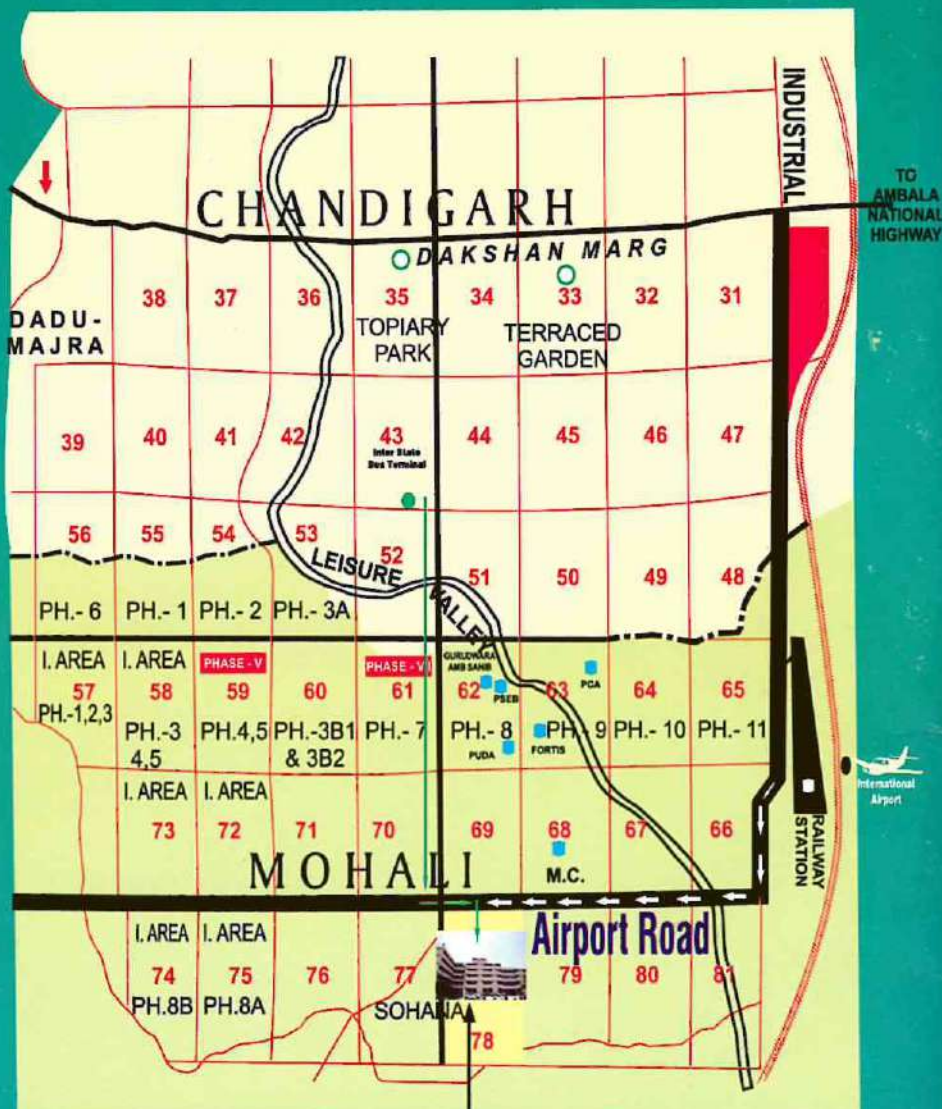
